**Our Construction Project: “The Oaks”**

The Oaks is a family style home located in a residential area of Blaine, which provides housing and services to three men and one woman who are quadriplegic and ventilator dependent. The house is owned by Becklund Outreach and Anoka County Community Action Program, both of which are non-profit organizations. The goal is to provide affordable community-based housing for severely handicapped individuals. If not for the Oaks, these individuals would need to live in an intensive care unit in a hospital or a highly skilled nursing facility. The house has been active for fifteen years and was in need of some serious home improvements. The operating budget at the Oaks is extremely limited. Through shared nursing of the residents, they are able to afford this type of housing, as they required around the clock professional nursing staff. There was no extra money for improvements on the house and they were looking at the possibility of shutting down the house when NAWIC started helping them out.

**NAWIC Accomplishments at the Oaks:**

Washed windows, stained deck, added new deck around back & side of house, wallpapered and painted, installed linoleum and carpet, changed lighting, paneled, replaced skylights, provided emergency generator, replaced sinks, replaced living room furniture, replaced stove/oven and microwave, installed blinds, fire sprinkler system in conjunction with Fire Sprinkler Local #417, also in conjunction with the Minnesota Concrete & Masonry Assoc. replaced 4800 s.f. of asphalt with concrete, and added 2 ceiling fans. This year we plan to replace the septic system and update the wood fireplace to gas.

**Our Community Help:**

For the past three years, our Chapter has volunteered of the **Hearts and Hammers**, an organization that assists homeowners who have limited access to home-improvement programs, specifically the elderly and those who are physically disabled. The Chapter has partnered with M.A. Mortenson. The Mpls/St. Paul Chapter is proud to be a part of the origination’s mission.
