TRADESWOMEN SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

- A. Applicant **must** be female.
- B. Applicant **must** be currently employed full-time in construction or enrolled full-time in a construction related apprenticeship training program.
- C. Applicant **must** desire a career in construction
- D. Applicant **must** be at least 18 years of age.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all items below are submitted to NAWIC Minneapolis-St. Paul Chapter #164 and postmarked by May 1st, 2008. Please attach requested documentation in the order shown:

1. Completed and signed Application Form.
2. Official transcript of grades from high school or technical college or university or apprenticeship training program.
3. Extracurricular Activities listing.
4. Employment History listing.
5. Advisor recommendation letter.

AWARDS

1. Scholarships are not automatically renewed. Candidates will be considered for subsequent awards if they provide evidence of continued need, continued interest in construction, and continued good standing in an apprenticeship training program or full-time construction related employment.
2. Applications will be reviewed and winners selected by the NAWIC Minneapolis-St. Paul Chapter #164 Scholarship Awards Committee. The Committee will consider applicant's interest in construction, extracurricular, activities, employment history, recommendation letter, and financial need.
3. Applicants will be notified of their award status, either via telephone, letter or e-mail, by June 6th, 2008.
4. Applicants receiving awards will be required to attend NAWIC's Minneapolis/St. Paul Chapter #164 - 35th Annual "Scramble" Golf Tournament Dinner, to receive award checks. This event is held at Majestic Oaks Golf Club in Ham Lake on June 26th, 2008, at 7:00 PM (plan on arriving around 6:30pm, unless informed otherwise).
